Can I vote if I have a criminal record? YES!!!

In the State of New Jersey, if you have successfully completed all of your parole or probation requirements, you may vote.

➤ Who cannot vote?

If you are convicted of a crime, your voter registration is deleted and you cannot vote. Individuals who are serving their sentence, on parole, or on probation cannot vote.

➤ Who can vote?

People who have successfully completed their parole or probation requirements.

Pre-trial detainees

People on bail pending an appeal

➤ How do I get my voting rights back after I have completed my sentence?

Once you have successfully completed all your sentence requirements, you must re-register to vote through your county elections office or go to www.nj.gov/state/elections to get a voter registration form online.
